## **Day 1 - April 23, 2026**

Individual arrival at a 4-star hotel in the Fasano/Alberobello area. Accommodation in bed & breakfast formula. Free time available for relaxation or a first independent exploration of the surroundings. In the late afternoon, meet your driver and depart for Locorotondo, one of the most charming villages in Puglia, renowned for its circular historic center and distinctive "cummerse"-style houses. Upon arrival, enjoy some free time for a leisurely stroll through flower-lined alleys, whitewashed houses, and scenic viewpoints over the Itria Valley. Next, transfer to a local winery, beautifully set in the rolling hills, offering a stunning view at sunset. Enjoy a tasting of local wines, accompanied by a selection of traditional Apulian appetizers. Return to the hotel in the evening. Dinner at leisure and overnight stay.

## **Day 2 - April 24, 2026**

After breakfast at the hotel, meet your driver and local guide for a full day dedicated to discovering some of the most charming villages in Puglia. The first stop is Martina Franca, an elegant Baroque town perched on the hills of the Itria Valley. Enjoy a walking tour of the historic center, featuring noble palaces, whitewashed alleyways, the stunning Basilica of San Martino, and typical inner courtyards. Free time to browse local artisan shops or enjoy a coffee in the heart of the town. Continue on to Cisternino, officially listed among the "Most Beautiful Villages in Italy". Known for its perfectly preserved old town and stone-paved lanes, Cisternino offers an authentic atmosphere and picturesque corners at every turn. Don't miss the chance to stroll through the village and admire the panoramic views over the countryside dotted with trulli and centuries-old olive trees. Lunch at leisure at the end of the visit. In the early afternoon, arrival in Alberobello, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, world-famous for its iconic trulli dwellings. Enjoy a guided tour of the Rione Monti and Rione Aia Piccola, with the option to visit a trullo-museum. Free time for shopping in local boutiques and tasting traditional products. Return to the hotel in the late afternoon. Dinner at leisure and overnight stay.

## **Day 3 - April 25, 2026**

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, meet your guide and driver for a full day exploring the Adriatic coast. Enjoy a guided tour of Monopoli, a charming seaside town with an authentic character, known for its whitewashed alleys, lively squares, and a picturesque castle overlooking the sea. Lunch at leisure in the center of Monopoli, with the opportunity to savor local specialties at one of the many restaurants along the port. In the early afternoon, continue on to Polignano a Mare, a gem of the Apulian coast, perched dramatically on cliffs

above the Adriatic Sea. Take a guided walk through its quaint streets, flower-filled balconies, scenic viewpoints, and visit the famous statue of Domenico Modugno, the beloved Italian singer. Dinner at leisure and overnight stay at the hotel.
