


# THINGS TO DO IN MILAN: THE PERFECT 5-DAY ITINERARY

## Day 1 - The Cathedral

Upon arrival at Milan airport, meet your private driver for the transfer to your hotel and check-in. The Duke of Milan commissioned the wall painting for the monastery. The Duke, Sforza, was a patron of the arts, specifically Leonardo da Vinci. Leonardo completed the painting in three years. When it was finished, it was immediately named a masterpiece. It depicts the dramatic scene described in several closely connected moments in the Gospels, in which Jesus declares that one of the Apostles will betray him and later institutes the Eucharist. The painting has deteriorated throughout the centuries and has been restored numerous times because Leonardo didn't use the usual technique to create the fresco; instead, he created a unique way to do it. That's why, despite all the restoration efforts, the painting remains fragile. After visiting the painting, enjoy a short visit to Santa Maria dell Grazie, one of the greatest examples of Renaissance art associated with the name of Leonardo da Vinci. At the end of the visit, stop for lunch at a suggested restaurant. After lunch, meet again your driver for the transfer to Brera District to continue your guided tour of some of Milan's highlights. The Brera District in Milan is one of the city's most charming and artistic neighborhoods, known for its cobblestone streets, vibrant atmosphere, and rich cultural history. Nestled just north of the city center, Brera is a hub for art, fashion, and gastronomy. At the end of the visit, return to the hotel accompanied by your private driver. peninsula of Lavedo, above the waters of central Lake Como, the Villa elegantly overlooks a sweeping panorama that makes it one of the most scenic residences on the Lario. At the end of the visit, transfer by boat to a local restaurant on the Lake to have lunch and some time at leisure. After lunch, embark back on your boat and once in Como again, meet your driver for the transfer back to Milan. Rest of the day and dinner at leisure.
